He has published his works in academic outlets such as *J. Bus. Res.*, *Int. J. Procure. Manag.*, and *Computer Games Journal*, and on international conferences (IPSER, IMP). He utilizes systematic literature reviews, meta-analysis and quantitative research methodology (factor analysis, cluster analysis, structural equation modelling) in his research.
