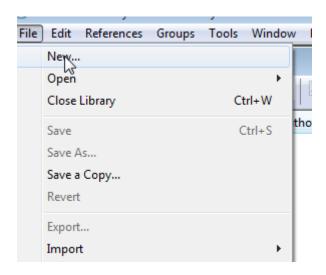


Create your EndNote library

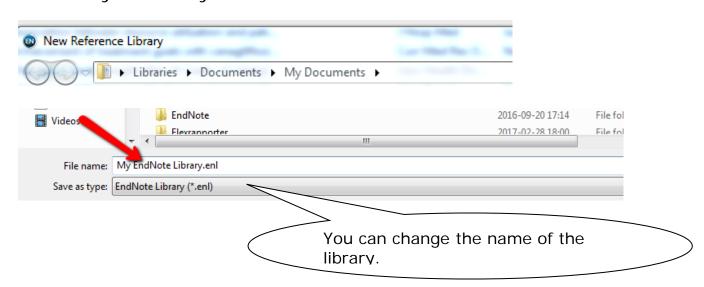
Open EndNote



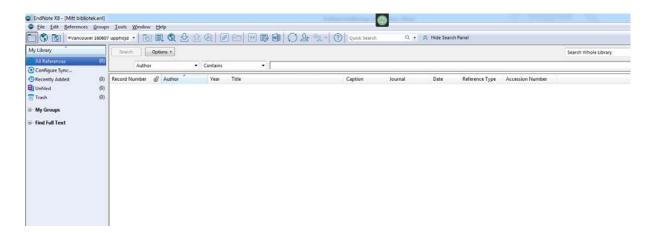
Go to File and then New

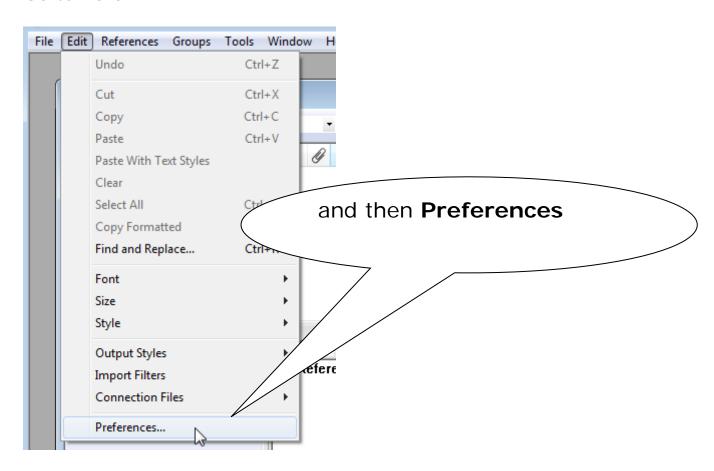


Your new EndNote library is created.

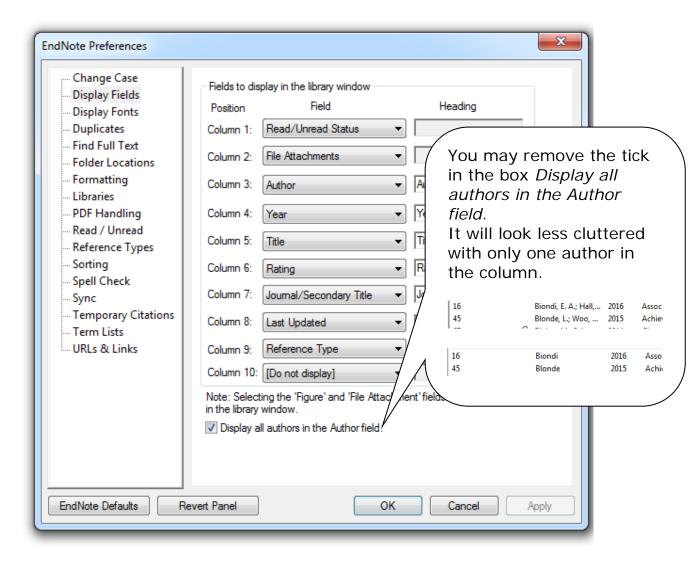


Before you start importing references some settings need to be changed.

Go to Edit

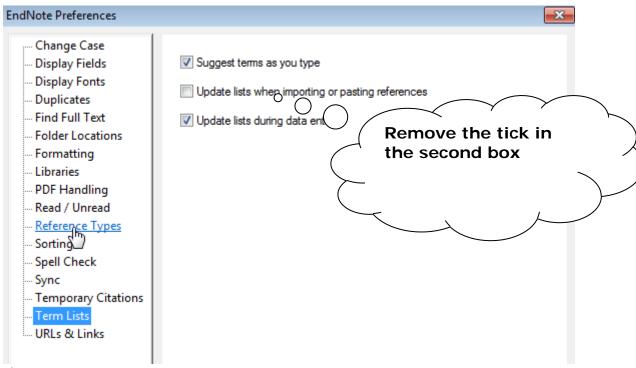


and Display Fields



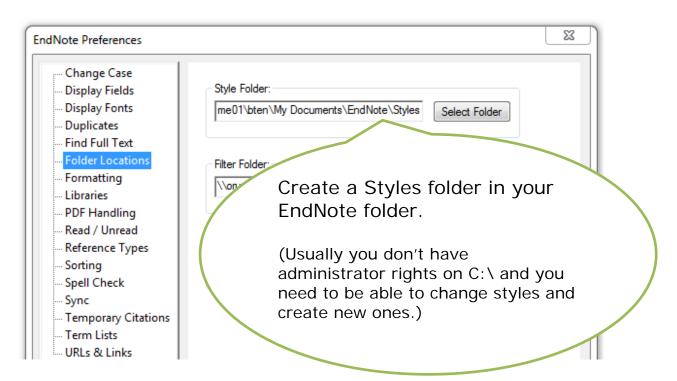
Record number, File attachments, Author, Year, Title, Journal/Secondary Title are useful display fields. If you change anything you have to click on **Apply** to make the change happen.

Next thing to look at is Term Lists



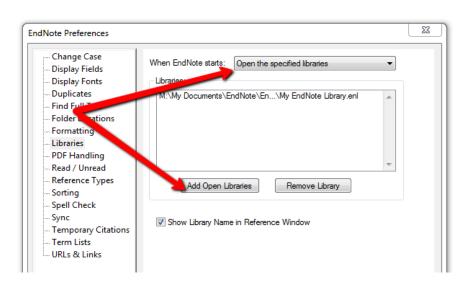
(Update lists when importing may ruin the Journal term list with the different variations of titles that we are going to import)

Go to **Folder Locations** and change the location of your Styles folder to (H:\) or (Documents).

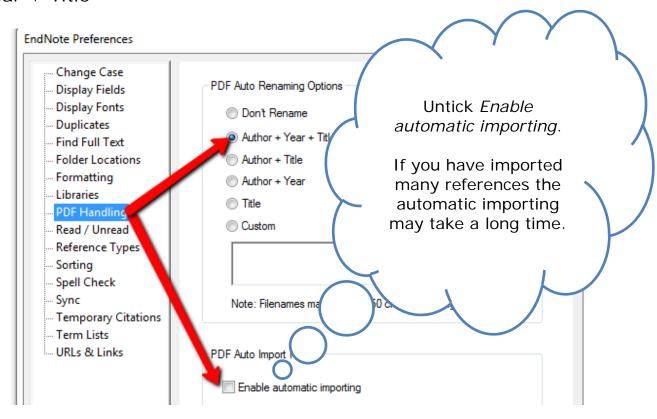


Do the following to enable EndNote to always open your library when EndNote starts:

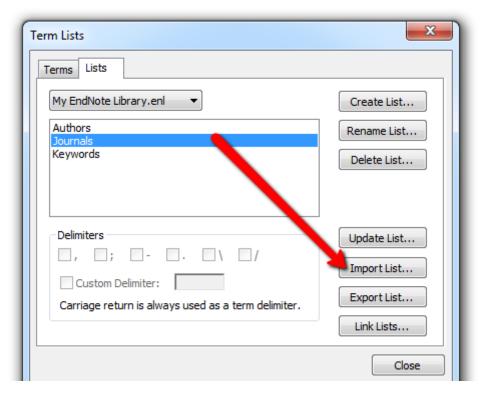
Go to Libraries, change to *Open the specified libraries* and click on *Add Open Libraries*



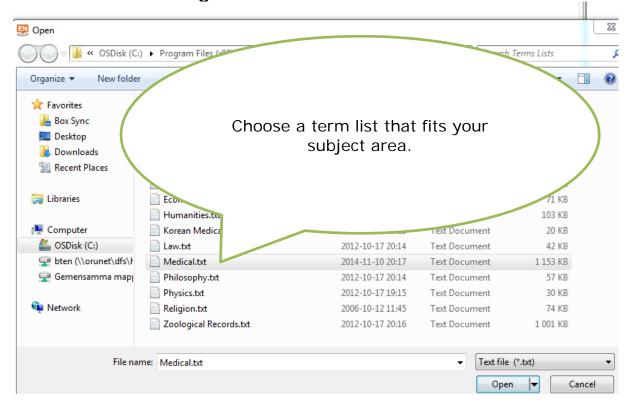
You can rename the pdfs you import; for example use Author + Year + Title

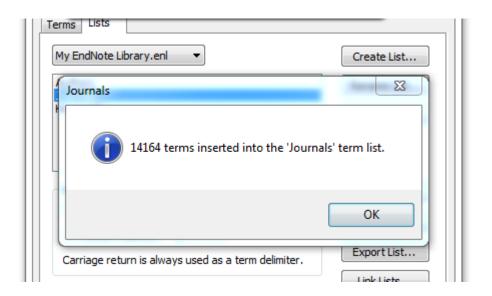


Next step is to import a **journal list**. Go to **Tools** and **Define Term Lists**

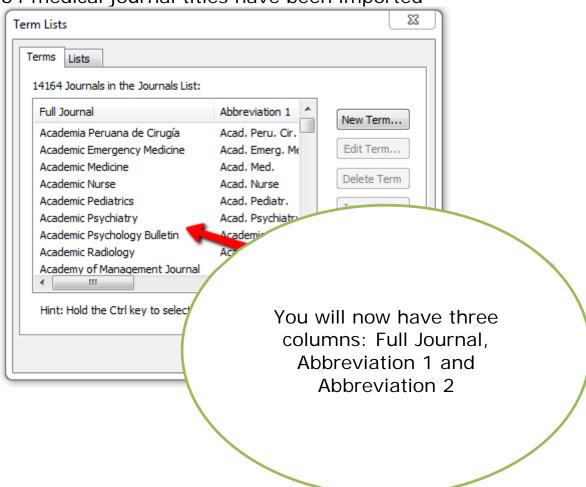


Mark Journals and click on Import List. The term list can be found in the folder Program\EndNote X8\Terms Lists.

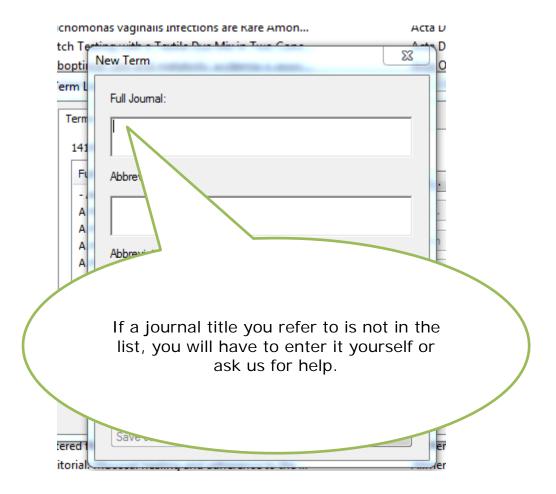




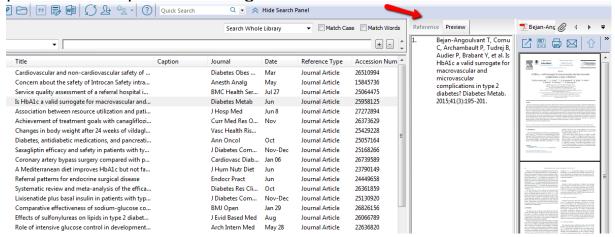

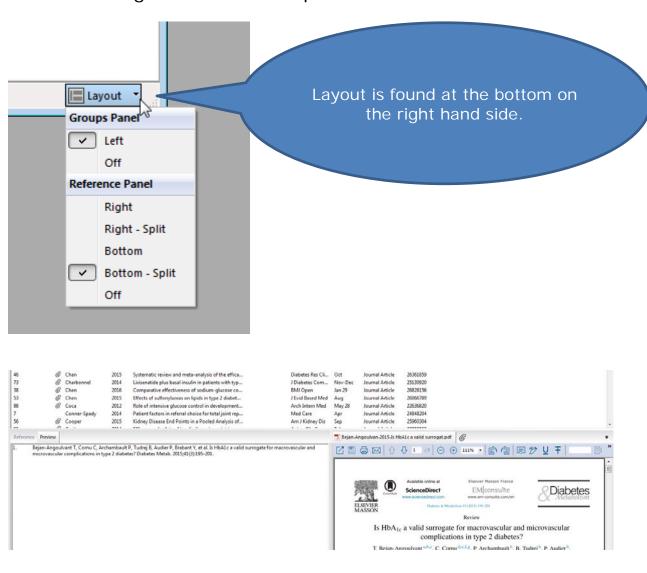
The Vancouver style will use Abbreviation 2; while for example APA uses Full Journal.



You can change the layout of your library. Below you see the preview and pdf on the right hand side.

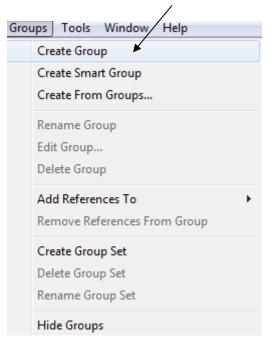


You can change it to Bottom- Split.

Click on Create Group under Groups



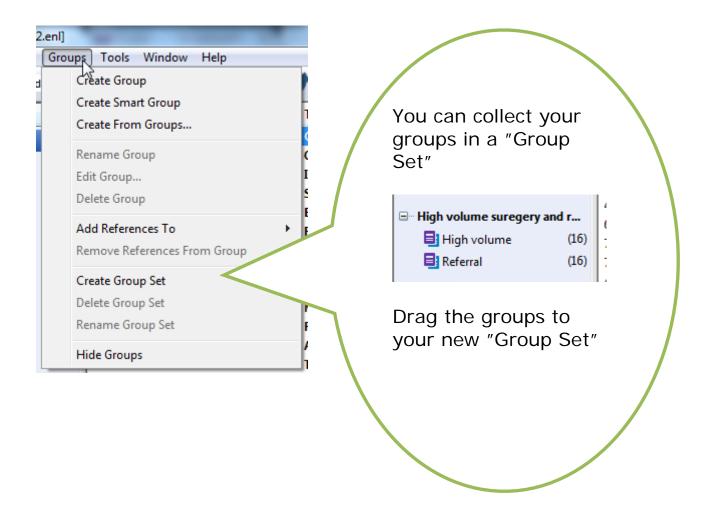

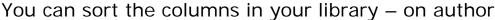


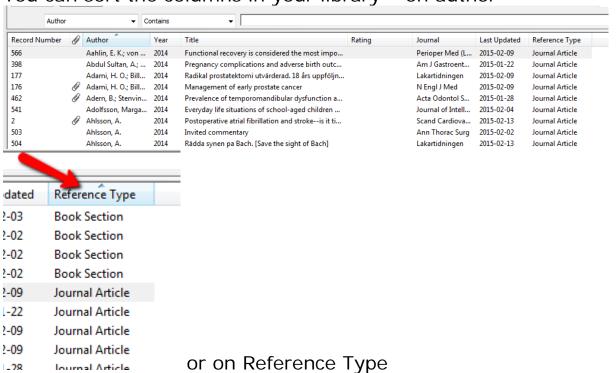
Select the references you want to add to your group and drag them there. A reference can be added to different groups. If you delete a reference in a group if will still remain in *All References*



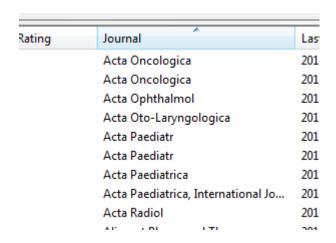
